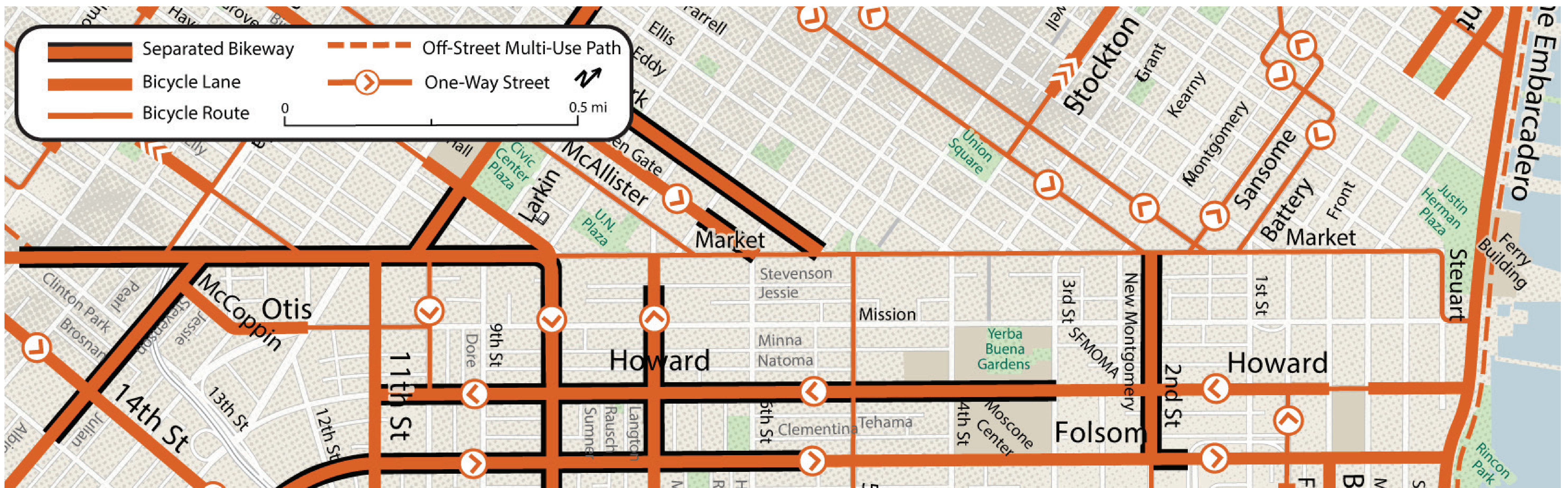

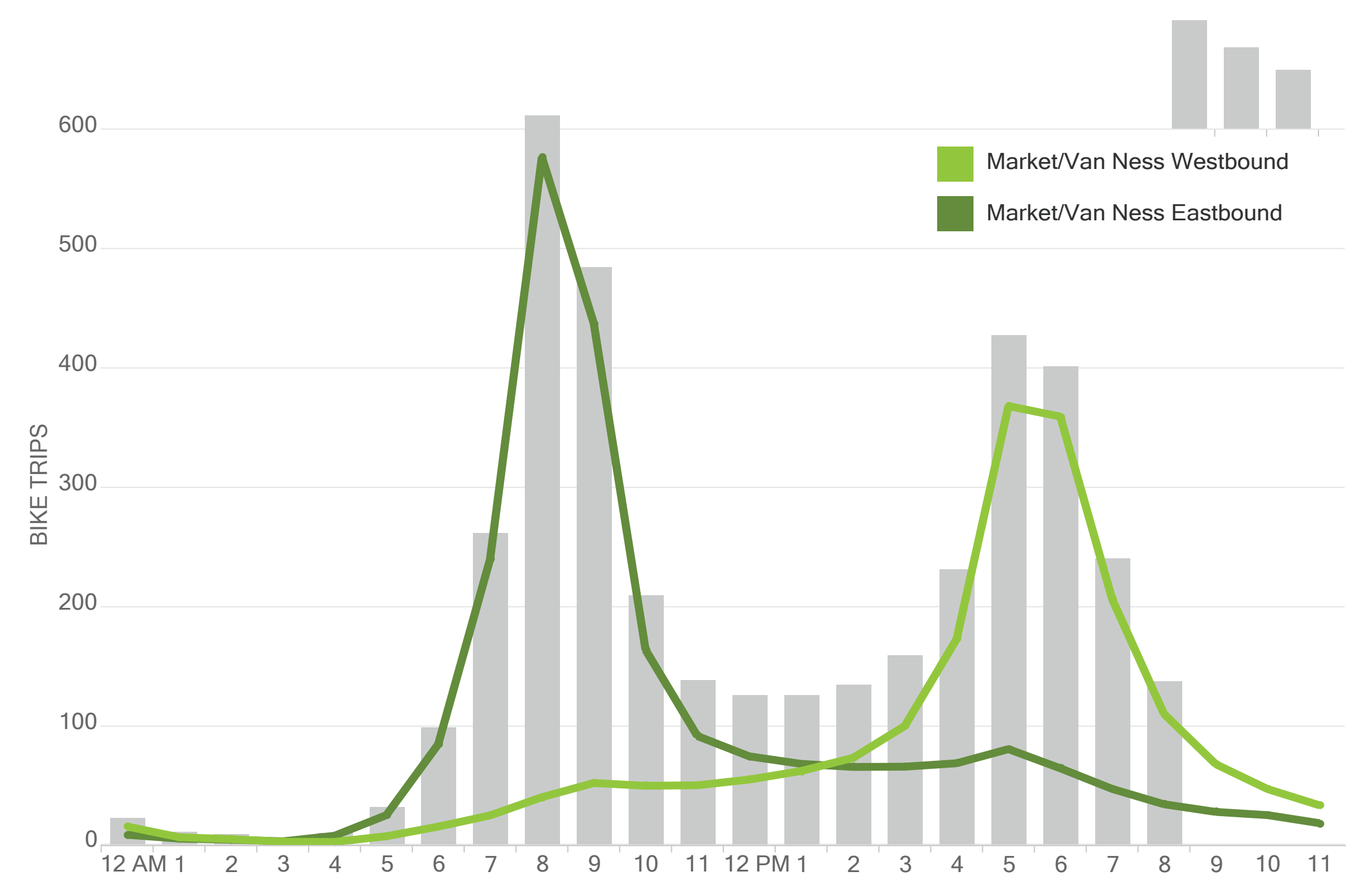

BIKING ON MARKET TODAY

Market Street is San Francisco's busiest biking street, with more than 1.2 million bike trips in 2017. Much of Market Street lacks adequate facilities to keep riders safe. East of Eighth Street, people bike in a shared lane with no protection from private and commercial vehicles and buses.



On an average weekday, more than 600 people bike on Market Street during the 8 a.m. peak hour. More than 4,000 bicyclists ride on Market each day.



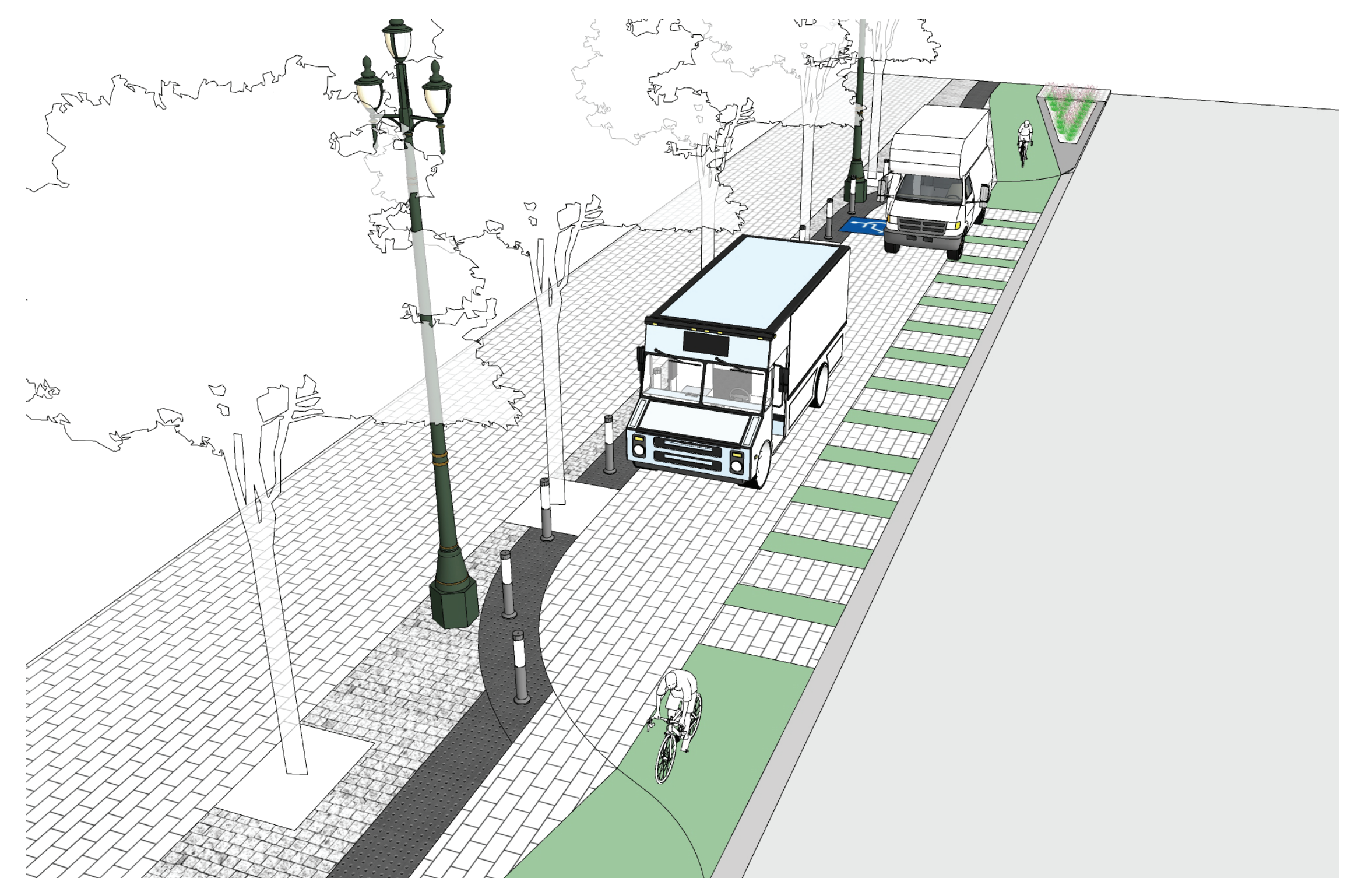
